STORYWALK AT THOUSAND HILLS

Come to Thousand Hills State Park to see

our StoryWalk! The StoryWalk Project was created by Anne Ferguson of Montpelier, VT, and developed in collaboration with the Kellogg-Hubbard Library also in Montpelier, VT. The StoryWalk concept has been used all 50 states and at least 12 other countries.

StoryWalks are stories that are out in nature and outside of traditional settings. The goal of the StoryWalk Project is to help build children's interest in reading while encouraging healthy outdoor activity for both adults and children. In many communities you can find StoryWalks in parks, sidewalks of popular routes, and many other places. However for your own local library ours is in our amazing state park! Adair County Public Library partnered with Thousand Hills State Park to provide a StoryWalk to our community so that they can

read while they enjoy our own local park!

This month's StoryWalk book is *What If Night by Paul Bogard*. This charming story, along with stunning watercolors of the night sky and wildlife, presents the thrill and wonder of a child exploring darkness without fear. Enjoying the stars and all the beauty of night. This story can be found along the Forest Lake Trail and is spread out half a mile.
