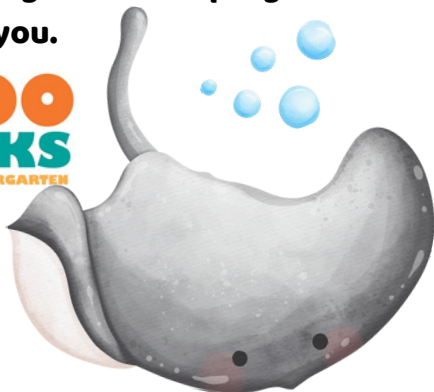


How to get started:

- 1. Read to your child. If you read three stories at bedtime every night for one year, you'll have shared 1,095 books!**
- 2. Fill in a circle for each story your child hears. Come back to the library when you have reached 100 books. Your child will get their new log, a sticker, and a certificate! You can also print the log in pdf form from our website.**
- 3. When you have finished 1,000 books your child will be able to win a new book! Your child will also be invited to a 1000 books before kindergarten celebration at the end of the year!**
- 4. It's up to you how you read! Need to play an audio of a story? Do they only want to read one book over and over? That's okay! You can record the same book more than once if your child has a favorite! If you read the book to multiple kids in the program they all get a number on their log. If you attend a storytime, Miss Bre's stories are counted as well! You can go through this at whatever pace you need and you have until your child enters Kindergarten. This program is made to work for you.**
